Birds face a lot of threats, from weather changes to the destruction of grassland. In this challenge, you will design an island paradise for these vulnerable animals.

Create an underwater habitat

Inventors are making plans for underwater cities. In this competition challenge, you will design your own underwater habitat to live in.



Design an eco-friendly home in the forest

Thousands of different animals live in forests across the world — but so do humans. In this competition challenge, you will design your own eco-friendly home in the forest.



Think about the design

Get students to think about the features of their habitat and what makes it sustainable or eco-friendly. Whether it's the type of habitat they're building, flowers to attract bees or how they'll make it comfortable - now's the time for their creative ideas to shine.



Step 3 Get building

Whether your students use LEGO bricks, creative materials (from paint to card to toilet rolls) or even just draw their design, they can bring their idea to life. If there's no time in class it can be set as homework - just print copies of this leaflet!
