



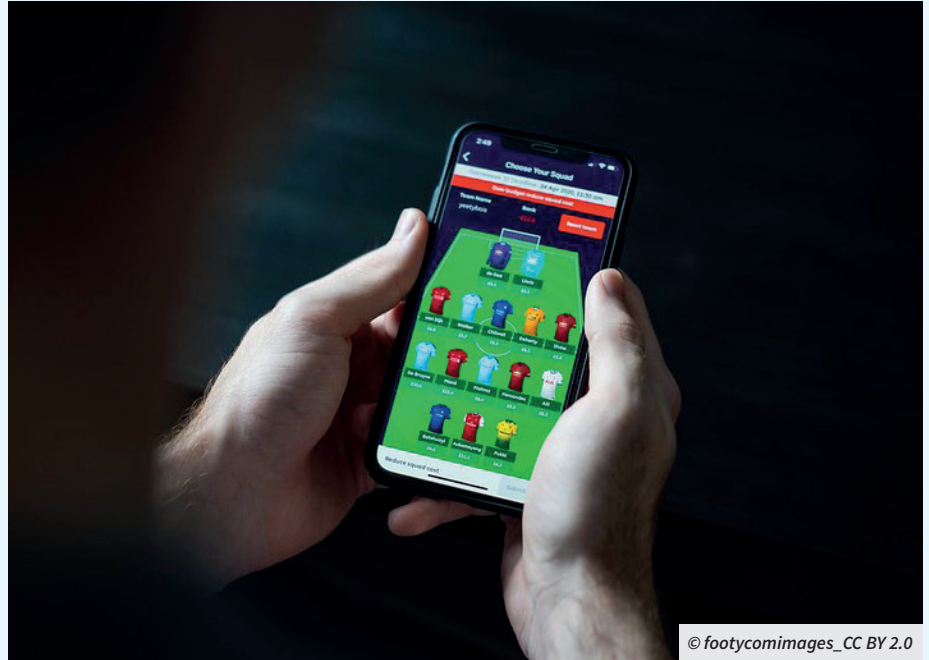

#### Fierce competitors

FPL is a truly global game, with the largest number of managers in England, Egypt, Nigeria, Malaysia and the US.

and rapper Stormzy. Stormzy listens to a **sports psychology** podcast to help choose his team!
