

## For & Against Line Debate - **Statements**

## Debate statements for teachers to read out as students place themselves on a line from 'strongly agree' to 'strongly disagree'.

- 1. At 16 you should have the vote because you pay taxes.
- 2. Young people aren't experienced enough to make political decisions.
- 3. Votes at 16 would strengthen democracy.
- 4. Schools should teach more politics if the voting age is lowered.
- 5. 16-year-olds are more likely to care about issues like climate change and the future.
- 6. Politicians might not listen to young people, even if they could vote.
- 7. Voting should stay at 18 because that's when most people leave school.
- 8. Lowering the voting age would make young people feel more respected and included.
- 9. 16-year-olds would just vote the same way as their parents this won't help to strengthen democracy.
